


WELLBEING

This term has flown by, and I can't believe we are nearing the last term of the year!
We have had some amazing weather recently which has been a welcome change to the winter cold of last term.



Some things we have been involved in this term have been....

- **Pyjama Day** which was so much fun coming to creche in our favourite PJ's. We raised about \$60 from this day which I think is fantastic. This money goes toward assisting children who are living in poverty, so every little bit helps.
- **Book Week** which saw the children dress up in their favourite costumes. They looked so adorable. We read our favourite stories during group time and then gave the children the opportunity to create the stories using props we provided.
- We made some super cute cards and mugs for Dads for Father's Day
- We had the **Police** come to visit us at Orroroo** and show us their police handcuffs and the police car. The siren was super loud. The children loved this experience.


**Hawker's visit is scheduled for the last day of term

We have focused a lot on outdoor play activities bringing balancing equipment, balls, bats, bikes, big shovels to dig and large connecting blocks. This helps the children get physically active and is extending them in their gross motor movement skills which are vital developmental milestones in the early years.

In group times, we have continued focusing on name recognition cards and following instructions through group games, using the whiteboards to draw shapes and letter writing. We sing our favourite songs which the children take turns in choosing.

Sensory play is always popular at creche and we try to change it up a bit from time to time. This term we have explored kinetic sand, flour and cereal pretend cooking experience. We've used Playdough with different tools and toys added and we even tried a vinegar and bicarb experiment which was also a hit.

We began Term 3 with Kindy Experience Days to welcome the 5 new children. Thank you to Thomas, Memphis and James for the awesome box constructions that became a dinosaur world. It has been a wonderful addition to the playroom.

Lenny, Cameron, and Thomas have researched the topics mini beasts, scientist, earth and space and dinosaurs. All three boys have really showed personality and self-confidence this term in preparation for school next year.

Term 3 midyear intake children Airlie, Asher, James, Jovie, and Memphis have been getting to know the kindy routine and talking on WebEx, focusing on 'Who am I' and fairy tales. I have chosen to run two separate programs as the children are in very different developmental areas and the half hour sessions are both demanding and limiting on four-year-old children.

Teagan and I have completed some new book packs that kindy families are encouraged to borrow for 2 to 3 weeks at a time before returning and borrowing another. New bags were purchased to ensure the safe travel of the books. We have also continued to create topic boxes for kindy children to explore when here in Port Augusta. The latest is a Doctor / RFDS box.

If you child turns 4 before May 1st 2024 they are eligible to start Preschool from the beginning of the year




